The objective is to promote and support students to propagate and contribute to various activities held at the College. Students take the responsibility to plan, organize, conduct, and review the events. This culture inculcates the spirit of teamwork and leadership amongst the students. The committees are as follows which endeavour to perform the following functions:

1. Moot Court Committee- The committee aims to organize Intra and Inter-batch Moot- Court competitions and organize such other competitions such as the Client Counselling Competition, Trial Advocacy, and Judgment Writing Competition and to bring training sessions to guide students about the various Legal Competition procedures. The society ensure the maximum participation of our students in various **moot- court** competitions organized by various colleges at both National and International levels.

2. Legal Aid and Awareness Committee: The committee aims to provide free legal aid to poor, needy persons and the members of the weaker sections of society and to carry out the social welfare activities through sensitizing people about their legal rights and duties. 3.
